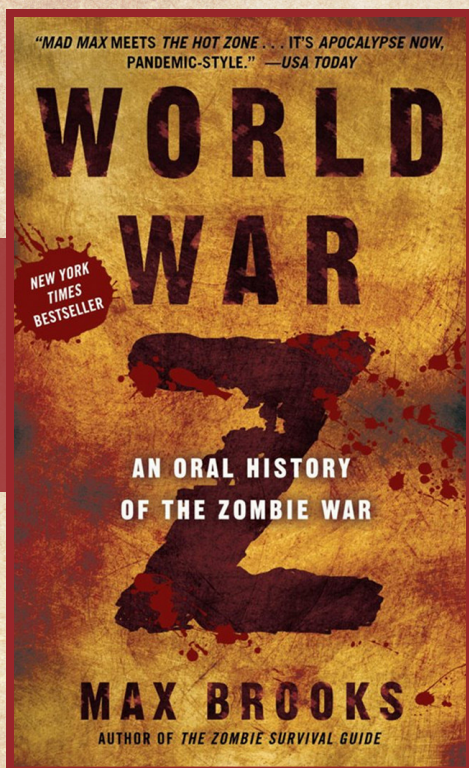


ALUMNI, STAFF, AND FACULTY BOOK CLUB
