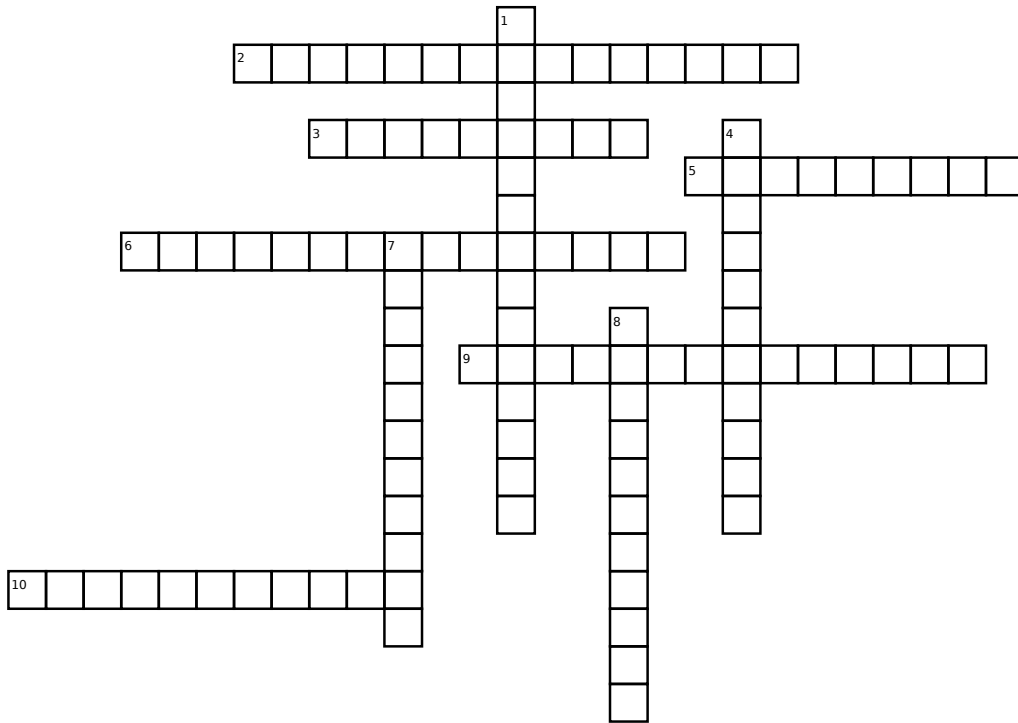


Escalette Crossword Puzzle
