Frederick Bourbon '12 is a Los Angeles based Digital Film Colorist, his coloring work ranges from Documentaries, Feature films to Music Videos and Shorts. Being trained as a cinematographer has enabled Freddy to balance the image from acquisition to final color for the utmost visual impact. Freddy's Visual Art installations have been exhibited at multiple international galleries including the one of a kind Bharat Bhavan Art Center in India.
